# The Anti-Violence Initiative

## 10 WEEK PROGRAM

**Phase 1 - 8 Weeks** - Counseling and Life Skills (will be conducted by two Non-profits Every Murder Is Remembered (**EMIR**) and Father's Day Rally Committee (FDRC) that are deeply rooted within our communities.

**Phase 2 - 2 Weeks** This phase will help the individuals learn how to create a resume and complete a job application. Provide an understanding of how to conduct themselves during the job interviewing process. Also, individuals that are interested in entrepreneurship will be introduced to PHA's Entrepreneurial Program.

**Follow Up** - To aid and support participants going on scheduled job interviews or enter PHA approved programs. Participants who have completed both Phases 1 & 2 will be on track for employment that will aid in the prevention of their being affected by gun violence. EMIR, FDRC and/or RAB will provide follow-up activities and check-ins.

***Participants and guests will be invited to a graduation ceremony to highlight their progress as it relates to the completion of this initiative and progress achieved.***

### Phase 1 completion

The individuals will receive a \$500 stipend at the conclusion of Phase 1. Individuals will also receive a certificate for completing Phase 1. Individuals will be able to understand how to POSITIVELY handle confrontational situations along with emotionally healing caused from previous traumatic experiences. Strengthen education/career goals and assistance with job training and employment. ***Have identified a community project, spearheaded by participants.***

### Phase 2 completion

The individuals will receive a \$500 stipend at the conclusion of Phase 2. Individuals will learn and possess the skills needed to have successful job interviews along with creating a resume that highlights their educational and occupational experiences. ***Have completed the community project.***
